Subject:

Tail rotor blades

Reason: Bonding due to improper possible separation of erosion protective shell.

Action and compliance:

- 1. Before next flight for blades change tail rotor blades with less than 5 hours in accordance with Alert Bulletin.
- 2. Inspect blades for delamination or separation of protective shell in accordance with Alert Bulletin before each flight.
