This Airworthiness Directive applies to AIRBUS INDUSTRIE A320 and A321 aircraft, all models without AIRBUS INDUSTRIE modification 24612 or AIRBUS INDUSTRIE Service Bulletin A320-31-1080.

In order to reduce lateral aircraft sensitivity during approach in case of flaps locked in FULL position, the following measures are rendered mandatory on the effective date of this Airworthiness Directive:

- Verify in the Aircraft Flight Manual incorporation of the Temporary Revision reference 9.99.99/20 dated June 14, 1994 and follows the instructions.
- When applying Airworthiness Directive 96-079-079(B), withdraw TR9.99.99/20 from Aircraft Flight Manual.
