DR 300 airplanes

Landing gear

This Airworthiness Directive concerns DR 300 airplanes all models, all serial number.

Report from field revealed a case of crack in the welding area of the gear legs. In order to avoid, a failure of bonding gear in the welding area between the wheel axle and the sliding strut, the following measures are made mandatory at the effective date of this Airworthiness Directive :

- Perform a dye penetrant inspection of the welding area between the wheel axle and the sliding strut of the front and main landing gear.
 - a) If no crack is discovered, return the airplane to service and perform a visual inspection each 50 hours T.I.S. and a dye penetrant inspection each 500 hours T.I.S.
 - b) If cracks are discovered, immediately replace the defective sliding leg before next flight.

Record the application of this Airworthiness Directive on the aircraft log book.
