Flaps locked (Improved Flight Warning Computer)

This Airworthiness Directive applies to AIRBUS INDUSTRIE A320 and A321 aircraft, all models without AIRBUS INDUSTRIE modification 24612 or AIRBUS INDUSTRIE Service Bulletin A320-31-1080.

In order to correct the ECAM procedure display on the EFIS in case of flaps locked in FULL position, the following measures are rendered mandatory on the effective date of this Airworthiness Directive:

- Before October 31, 1996, install improved Flight Warning Computer (FWC) in both positions in accordance with AIRBUS INDUSTRIE Service Bulletin A320-31-1080.

Application of this Airworthiness Directive cancels the requirements of Airworthiness Directive 94-211-059(B)R1 (See Revision 2 of this Airworthiness Directive).
