Wing to fuselage upper fairings

This Airworthiness Directive applies to all serial numbers of FAN JET FALCON AIRCRAFT, and to MYSTERE FALCON 20-(x)5 and MYSTERE FALCON 20 GF.

In order to prevent the risk of loosing wing-to-fuselage upper fairings, the following instructions are mandatory :

- 1- Within a time limit not exceeding 7 months or 330 flying hours (whichever limit is reached first) from the effective date of this airworthiness directive, check the wing-to-fuselage fairings and add cupwashers below the screws attaching the vertical seams of the upper fairings in compliance with procedure 53-50-0 § 3 of the maintenance manual DMD 11752 DASSAULT AVIATION for all serial numbers of FAN JET FALCON Aircraft and for MYSTERE FALCON 20 GF and MYSTERE FALCON 20 -(x)5.
- 2- Later, perform the inspection of wing-to-fuselage fairings at intervals not exceeding 6 months or 300 flying hours (whichever limit is reached first) with a non cumulative tolerance of 1 month or 30 flying hours in compliance with the procedure as defined in § 1.
