Lavatories - Pressure difference between toilet and cabin

This Airworthiness Directive applies to AIRBUS INDUSTRIE A300 aircraft, all certified models and all serial numbers, equipped with MONOGRAM type toilets, on which :

- AIRBUS INDUSTRIE serial modification n° 4256 or 2120
or
- AIRBUS INDUSTRIE Service Bulletin A300-38-034 rev. 3 would not have been embodied.

In order to prevent excessive differential pressure between the cabin and the toilet which is directly vented to outside the aircraft which could cause considerable suction on the occupant, the following measures are rendered mandatory from the effective date of this Airworthiness Directive :

- Before December 31, 1998, modify the toilets in accordance with the instructions of AIRBUS INDUSTRIE Service Bulletin A300-38-034 rev. 3.
