101VU panel wire bundle wear due to chafing

This Airworthiness Directive applies to AIRBUS INDUSTRIE A310 and A300-600 aircraft, all certified models and all serial numbers, on which the following AIRBUS INDUSTRIE Service Bulletins have been embodied :

A310-24-2072, A310-24-2067, A300-24-6064 or A300-24-6058.

In order to prevent and detect any wear of the electrical generation wires installed in the 101VU panel, due to chafing, which could result in a short circuit and lead to the loss of the DC NORMAL BUS and AC BUS 1 and AC BUS 2, the following measures are rendered mandatory from the effective date of this Airworthiness Directive :

within 400 hours following the effective date of this airworthiness Directive, without exceeding August 31st, 1997, conduct a visual inspection of the 101VU panel electrical installation and take the corrective actions if necessary, in accordance with the instructions of AIRBUS INDUSTRIE A.O.T. 24-08 dated April 17, 1997.
