Subject: Global Alternative Methods of Compliance (AMOC) Request for Airworthiness Directive (AD) 2012-06-01.

The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) has received your proposal contained in the referenced Cessna letter, dated April 22, 2013, proposing an alternative method of compliance (AMOC) to Airworthiness Directive (AD) 2012-06-01 paragraph (g).

The Wichita Aircraft Certification Office approves your AMOC proposal to paragraph (g) of AD 2012-06-01. This will extend the compliance time of AD 2012-06-01 to July 25, 2013. This approval is based on the information contained in your Cessna Letter L390-13-0781 and requires the following.

1. AD 2012-06-01 must be accomplished by July 25, 2013.
2. Inspect the areas and drain holes specified in Cessna Alert Service Letter ASL560XL-53-08 identified in paragraph (h) of AD 2012-06-01. Verify the drain holes and areas referenced by ASL560XL-53-08 are free of debris that could obstruct draining of water. This inspection must be accomplished by May 10, 2013.

In accordance with FAA Order 8110.103A, dated September 28, 2010, the following conditions apply:


1. All provisions of AD 2012-06-01 that are not specifically referenced above remain fully applicable and must be complied with accordingly.
2. This approval is applicable only to Cessna Aircraft Model 560XL airplanes as described in paragraph (c) of AD 2012-06-01.
3. This approval is based on the information contained in your reference letter which requires an inspection of all areas and drain holes specified in the Cessna Alert Service Letter ASL560XL-53-08 identified in paragraph (h) of AD 2012-06-01

4. This approval is transferable.

Before using this AMOC, notify your appropriate principal inspector, or lacking a principal inspector, the manager of the local flight standards district office/certificate holding district office.
