

## **EASA Decision not to adopt FAA AD 2017-12-01**

## EASA considerations, leading to the decision not to adopt FAA AD 2017-12-01

On 8 June 2017, FAA issued <u>AD 2017-12-01</u>, applicable to certain Boeing 767 aeroplanes, modified by Boeing (Wichita) Supplemental Type Certificate (STC) <u>ST01329WI-D</u>.

The purpose of the STC is to create a "convertible passenger to freighter and combi" aeroplane and the modification instructions include "structural, electrical [and] hydraulics provisions for aerial refuelling and military avionics systems".

EASA has determined that this STC is not validated in Europe. The resulting configuration is effectively a military aeroplane, not eligible for an EASA Certificate of Airworthiness.

Based on those findings, EASA cannot adopt the AD, as it applies to aeroplanes modified by a non-validated STC, affecting (military) aeroplanes not registered in EASA MS.
