It affects aviation safety and requires your immediate attention. No person may operate an aircraft to which an Airworthiness Directive applies, except in accordance with that Directive.

APPLIES TO: Gulfstream Aerospace LP models GALAXY and G200 aircraft, serial

numbers 101 through 104, 109, 110 & 118 certificated in any category.

SUBJECT: Recall and replacement of defective Pressurization Safety Valves

P/N 103842-3 in accordance with Honeywell Service Bulletin No.

103842-21-4126 as adopted by Gulfstream SB 200-21-308.

REASON: During the manufacturing process of the Poppet Covers of the Pressurization

Safety Valves, burrs that could damage the Valve Diaphragms were not removed. The damage may eventually cause faulty operation of the relief valves resulting in an unsafe condition when combined with additional failures. The serial numbers of the defective valves and the affected aircraft

were identified.

ACTION: Replace the Pressurization Safety Valve P/n 103842-3 according to

Gulfstream Mandatory Service Bulletin No. 200-21-308 Rev. NEW or later

approved revision thereof.

COMPLIANCE: Compliance with this service bulletin is mandatory at the next "A" check, but

no later than January 28, 2008.

EFECTIVE DATE: March 6, 2007.
