AIRWORTHINESS DIRECTIVE

This Airworthiness Directive, issued by the Civil Aviation Administration in accordance with the Israeli Aviation Regulations, applies to an aircraft for which our records list you as the registered owner. It affects aviation safety and requires your immediate attention. No person may operate an aircraft, to which an Airworthiness Directive applies, except in accordance with that Directive.

- APPLIES TO:** Israel Aircraft Industries Models GALAXY and Gulfstream 200 aircraft, all serial numbers certificated in any category.
- SUBJECT:** Incorporation of new take-off performance tables in the Airplane Flight Manual.
- REASON:** The engine manufacturer (P&WC) has corrected the power setting logic and table limits in the performance model, which requires revised performance tables in the AFM.
- ACTION:** Incorporate temporary revision no. 7 in the Airplane Flight Manual.
- COMPLIANCE:** Is required within 50 flight hours after the effective date of this Airworthiness Directive.
- EFFECTIVE DATE:** 30 September, 2003.
