Subject: Universal/Global Alternative Method of Compliance (AMOC) for Airworthiness
Directive (AD) 89-25-08, Amendment 39-6410

The letter grants an alternative method of compliance (AMOC) for AD 89-25-08. This AMOC allows the use of Hawker Beechcraft Corporation, Structural Inspection and Repair Manual (SIRM), Part Number, 98-39006C4, dated November 2008, in lieu of SIRM 98-39006A4, dated May 4, 1987.

This AMOC is a universal AMOC applicable to all models and serial numbers as listed in the AD. This AMOC is transferable to any owner-operator and is valid until canceled or until other revisions require updates.

Before using this AMOC, notify your appropriate principal inspector (PI) in the FAA Flight Standards District Office (FSDO) or, lacking a PI, the local FSDO. This approval is subject to the following condition: If in the future the Wichita ACO or the Small Airplane Directorate determines that this AMOC does not provide an acceptable level of safety, then these authorities may revoke or revise the terms of the AMOC following notice to the requester and a seven-day opportunity for the requester to comment on the revocation or proposed revision.
