- **Compliance:** As indicated, but not later than 31 August 2002, unless already accomplished.
- **Background:** While performing a regular maintenance activity, there is a possibility of installing the existing Tee fitting (P/N AS1003W060404) in such a way that the hydraulic fluid flow will be significantly restricted. To preclude this possibility, a new Tee fitting installation has been designed.
- Corrective At the next scheduled hydraulic filter and fluid replacement, replace the Tee fitting P/N AS 1003W060404 and tubes P/N 427-080-058-101, 427-080-003-101 with Union P/N AS 5230W0606, Tee fitting P/N NAS1763W060404 and tubes P/N 427-080-069-101, 427-080-068-101, as per instructions outlined in Alert Service Bulletin (ASB) 427-01-02 dated 20 August 2001, or later revisions approved by Chief, Continuing Airworthiness, Transport Canada.
