Floodlight Panel – Cockpit Floodlight Water Penetration

Applicability:

Bombardier Inc. model CL-600-2B16 (650 variant) aeroplanes, serial numbers 6050 through 6070.

Compliance:

Within 38 months from the effective date of this AD, unless already accomplished.

Background:

AD CF-2016-40, applicable to Bombardier Inc. model CL-600-2B16 (604 and 605 variants) aeroplanes, was issued to address the potential of water penetrating into cockpit floodlight fixtures. A similar condition exists on the CL-600-2B16 (650 variant) aeroplanes. This condition can cause short circuits and damage to electrical components, which may result in a fire in the cockpit.

This AD mandates the installation of gasket seals on the pilot and co-pilot floodlight fixtures to prevent fluid from entering them.

Corrective Actions:

Install the new gasket seals, Modification Summary 600-6537. Bombardier Service Bulletin (SB) 650-33-001, Revision 2, dated 11 March 2016, or later revisions approved by the Chief, Continuing Airworthiness, Transport Canada, provides approved instructions to install the new gasket seal.

Previous revisions of the above-mentioned SB also provide approved instructions to install the new gasket seal.
