> use of incorrect pressure testing procedures during manufacturing. Field sampling of nine aeroplanes have confirmed this condition. When the oxygen system is used, oil

contaminants can cause an ignition and result in a fire in the oxygen system.

This AD mandates the cleaning of the crew oxygen system to reduce oil

contaminants to a safe level.

Corrective

Clean the crew oxygen system in accordance with the Accomplishment Instructions Actions: Service Bulletin (SB) 670BA-35-012, Revision

26 November 2012, or later revisions approved by the Chief, Continuing

Airworthiness, Transport Canada.
