

## **EASA Decision not to adopt FAA AD 2023-02-02**

## EASA considerations, leading to the decision not to adopt Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) AD 2023-02-02

On 18 January 2023, the FAA issued <u>AD 2023-02-02</u>, applicable to Gulfstream Aerospace Corporation Model GV and GV-SP aeroplanes. This AD was prompted by the omission of a life limit in the airworthiness limitation section (ALS) for a certain main landing gear (MLG) trunnion pin.

That AD requires revising the ALS of the existing instructions for continued airworthiness (ICA) or inspection program for the aeroplane to establish a life limit for the affected MLG trunnion pin.

During the validation of the aeroplane, EASA required more conservative life cycle limits for safelife landing gear components, than required by FAA AD 2023-02-02.

For the reason described above, EASA has decided not to adopt FAA AD 2023-02-02.
