Description: Several NOTAMs and other aeronautical publications were issued recently by, respectively, ASECNA and Ghana related the provision of air traffic services for airspace above Togo, Benin, and the oceanic airspace south of those countries, within the Accra FIR.

The published aeronautical information may lead to uncertainty regarding which ATSU is in charge of providing ATC service in the oceanic airspace south of Togo and Benin.

This SIB is issued to draw the attention of operators, planning flights in the affected airspace, and attention of their respective NAAs, to the situation as described above.
