AEROSPATIALE SA 365 C, C1, C2 and C3 Helicopters

Flight cycle calculation

This Airworthiness Directive concerns AEROSPATIALE SA 365 helicopters, C, C1, C2, and C3 version.

Subsequent to the issuing of the following PRE regarding SA 365 C, C1, C2, C3, Edition 1, revision 17 dated 87-22, the service life limits of parts listed in chapter 5.99 (Airworthiness limitations) are expressed in :

- operating hours,
- or cycles,
- or hours and cycles (the first value reached being considered).

The methods for calculating the cycles and for converting operations hours into cycles are stated in § 1 C(2) and 1 C(3) of AEROSPATIALE SA 365 C n° 01.20 Service Bulletin .

For parts having reached or exceeded the service life limit in cycles, after conversion of hours to cycles, on the date that this Airworthiness Directive comes into effect, the following measures are mandatory :

- 1/- Scrap and replace the parts in service concerned within the next 100 flight hours.
- 2/- Scrap the replacement parts concerned.
