Electrical cabinet

The present Airworthiness Directive applies to AS 332 helicopters, versions C, C1, L and L1, fitted with an electrical cabinet cover panel which is made in one or two pieces.

Further to a report indicating a short circuit on panel 2 ALPHA, the following measures are rendered mandatory :

- After the last flight of the day following the effective date of the present Revision 1 (if this was not already done in accordance with the original Airworthiness Directive) and thereafter each time the panel is removed/installed or replaced, comply with paragraph 1C(1) or 1C(2) of EUROCOPTER FRANCE AS 332 Service Bulletin No 01.31 R1.
