Hydraulic fire shut-off valve Westland - Sitec P/N EO3000

This Airworthiness Directive applies to all certified models AIRBUS INDUSTRIE A330 aircraft fitted with fire shut-off valves, P/N EO3000 (Westland - Sitec) which have not received AIRBUS INDUSTRIE modification 44066 or AIRBUS INDUSTRIE Service Bulletin A330-29-3018.

In order to detect an improper functioning of the fire shut-off valves which may result in an incomplete closure/opening, the following measures are rendered mandatory on the effective date of this Airworthiness Directive, unless already accomplished:

- Not later than November 30, 1995 perform on operational test on the (4) four hydraulic shut-off valves, followed by a check to ensure that the FSOV electrical motors have stopped, in accordance with the instructions given in AIRBUS INDUSTRIE All Operator Telex (A.O.T.) 29-15 dated May 30, 1995.
