AS 332 Helicopters

Tail rotor blades

This Airworthiness Directive applies to AS 332 helicopters, versions C, C1, L and L1, on which modifications 332A07-41569 and 332A07-66150 have not been embodied. These modifications correspond to ensuring compliance with EUROCOPTER FRANCE AS 332 Service bulletin N° 64.00.22 (Tail Rotor: Improved Resistance to Lightning Strike).

Further to a ditching in the North Sea that was caused by an extremely severe lightning strike, the following measure is rendered mandatory from the effective date of this Airworthiness Directive :

- Flights in foreseeable or confirmed stormy areas are prohibited for aircraft that are not equipped with tail rotor blades that have been reinforced against lightning strike.
