Fuselage - Reinforcement of the structure at section 18

Applicability :

A320 AIRBUS INDUSTRIE aircraft all certified models without AIRBUS INDUSTRIE modification 22764 in production or AIRBUS INDUSTRIE Service Bulletins A320-53-1110 and A320-53-1131.

Reason :

In order to increase strength margin in case of undetected tail scrape of the rear part of the fuselage with the ground, the fuselage structure at section 18 has to be reinforced.

Actions :

Mandatory on the effective date of this Airworthiness Directive, unless already accomplished :

Before January 13, 2002, reinforce the fuselage at section 18 in accordance with the instructions of :

- AIRBUS INDUSTRIE Service Bulletin A320-53-1110 for frames 68 and 69 and,
- AIRBUS INDUSTRIE Service Bulletin A320-53-1131 for frames 65 to 67.
