Main Gear Box

1. EFFECTIVITY

This Airworthiness Directive applies to SE 3160, SA 316B, SA 316C and SA 319B helicopters equipped with main gear boxes (MGB), all part numbers, which are not modified by MOD 072241.

2. REASON

This Airworthiness Directive is issued following bevel wheel gear attachment bolt failure which could lead to dammage to the MGB and then the loss of the rotor drive.

3. MANDATORY ACTIONS AND COMPLIANCE

From the effective date of this Airworthiness Directive :

- **3.1.** Carry out a daily check on the magnetic plug after the last flight of the day.
- 3.2. Check the oil filter every 25 hours.
- 3.3. Comply with the instructions given on work card 5.41.202 if the MGB oil is polluted.
