1. APPLICABILITY:

AIRBUS INDUSTRIE A319, A320 and A321 all certified models, all serial numbers without AIRBUS INDUSTRIE modifications 25896 or 25592 or 25593 in production or AIRBUS INDUSTRIE Service Bulletins A320-53-1128.

2. REASON:

Between frames FR37 and FR41, during inspection program of fastener holes of frame feet left and right hand sides as per Service Bulletin A320-53-1025, cracks were found around fastener holes.

3. ACTION:

- 1. Inspect frames and frame feet in accordance with thresholds and instructions defined in AIRBUS INDUSTRIE Service Bulletin A320-53-1141 and apply if necessary corrective actions.
- 2. Repeat the inspection at intervals as defined in AIRBUS INDUSTRIE Service Bulletin A320-53-1141 until accomplishment of AIRBUS INDUSTRIE Service Bulletin A320-53-1128.

The total application of Service Bulletin A320-53-1128 cancels the requirements of this Airworthiness Directive.
