Passenger doors safety pin greasing (ATA 52)

#### **APPLICABILITY:**

AIRBUS INDUSTRIE A320 and A321 aircraft, all certified models, all serial numbers having received AIRBUS INDUSTRIE Service Bulletin A320-52-1057 at Revision 5 dated February 27,1998 [this Service Bulletin is mandated by Airworthiness Directive 94-239-060 (B)].

New production aircraft with modification 24389 embodied are not affected by this Airworthiness Directive.

## **REASON:**

On AIRBUS INDUSTRIE Service Bulletin A320-52-1057 at Revision 5 dated February 27, 1998 the instruction task asking for greasing of the rods, fittings and locking devices is incorrect which could induce the jamming of passenger doors during opening.

#### **COMPLIANCE:**

Before August 31, 2000 perform the greasing task in accordance with AIRBUS INDUSTRIE Service Bulletin A320-52-1057 at Revision 6.
