Nose gear fork (ATA 32)

1. APPLICABILITY

The present Airworthiness Directive (AD) is applicable to EADS SOCATA TB 9, TB 10 and TB 200 aeroplanes serial numbers 2054, 2074 through 2155 and 2184.

2. <u>REASONS</u>

Possibility of inverted material grain flow due to a wrong manufacturing process.

3. MANDATORY ACTIONS AND COMPLIANCE TIMES

The following measures are made mandatory from the effective date of this Airworthiness Directive:

During the next major inspection and at the latest on December 31, 2003, check and if necessary replace the nose gear fork.

Accomplish these actions according to the instructions given in the EADS SOCATA Service Bulletin in reference.
