APPLICABILITY:

This Airworthiness Directive applies to AIRBUS INDUSTRIE 340 aircraft models -211, -212, -213, -311, -312 and -313 which have neither received AIRBUS INDUSTRIE modification 44043 nor AIRBUS INDUSTRIE modification 43961 (or AIRBUS NDUSTRIE Service Bulletin A340-53-4072 at initial issue or any further approved revision).

REASONS:

During full fatigue tests, comes was found at the cover plate of the torsion box of the aft passenger/crew door at FR73A and FR74A.

If not corrected, this puld sult in reduced structural capability of the rear fuselage.

COMPLIANCE:

The following measures are rendered mandatory on the effective date of this Airworthiness Directive, unless already previously accomplished:

- Before accumulation of 8750 flights since first flight of the aircraft, reinforce the cover plate of the torsion box of the aft passenger/crew door, LH and RH, in accordance with the instructions given in AIRBUS INDUSTRIE Service Bulletin A340-53-4072.
