1. **EFFECTIVITY**:

EC 130 B4 helicopters equipped with one or two lateral cargo hold doors not modified per MOD 073542 (or in compliance with EUROCOPTER EC 130 Service Bulletin (SB) No. 52-005).

Note: This Airworthiness Directive (AD) is intended for maintenance personnel and crews.

2. REASONS:

This AD is issued following a case of unlocking of the center lock of a lateral cargo hold door during a test flight at the works.

Unlocking of the center lock in flight, combined with aerodynamic loads, could lead to the failure of the lateral lock and result in the loss of the cargo hold door.

Revision 1 of this AD:

- covers the conversion of EUROCOPTER EC 130 Alert Telex No. 04A001 into an Alert Service Bulletin (ASB) bearing the same reference number,
- informs you that the embodiment of MOD 073542 (or compliance with EUROCOPTER EC 130 SB No. 52-005) on both lateral cargo hold doors, cancels compliance with this AD.

3. MANDATORY ACTIONS AND COMPLIANCE TIMES:

The following measure is rendered mandatory from the effective date of the original issue of this AD:

- Prior to each flight, key-lock the center lock of the right and left lateral cargo hold doors in compliance with the instructions given in § 1.E.2.a. of EUROCOPTER EC 130 ASB No. 04A001 referenced below.
