AIRWORTHINESS DIRECTIVE

This Airworthiness Directive, issued by the Civil Aviation Authority of Israel in accordance with the Israeli Air Navigation Regulations applies to an aircraft for which our records list as under your registration or you as the registered owner. It affects aviation safety and requires your immediate attention. No person may operate an aircraft to which an Airworthiness Directive applies, except in accordance with that Directive.

APPLIES TO: All G200 / Galaxy Model Aircrafts

SUBJECT: **G200 Airworthiness Limitations Section (ALS) revision**

REASON: Aircraft Maintenance Manual (AMM) ALS (sections 05-10-10 & 05-10-11) updates. Updates to these sections, incorporated in the G200 AMM revisions 38 and 39, include:

- Change to inspection method
- Addition of an inspection location
- Changes to initial and/or repeat inspection intervals

ACTION: G200 operators to incorporate AMM Revision 39 or later CAAI approved revision.

COMPLIANCE: Unless already accomplished, comply with the above action within 90 days of the effective date of this AD.

EFFECTIVE DATE: 01 SEP, 2025.
