AIRWORTHINESS DIRECTIVE

This Airworthiness Directive, issued by the Civil Aviation Authority of Israel in accordance with the Israeli Air Navigation Regulations applies to an aircraft for which our records list as under your registration or you as the registered owner. It affects aviation safety and requires your immediate attention. No person may operate an aircraft to which an Airworthiness Directive applies, except in accordance with that Directive.

APPLIES TO: 1124 & 1124A Westwind models - all aircrafts.

SUBJECT: Changes to the 1124 & 1124A Westwind models AFMs

REASON: To ensure thrust reverser system proper status and function while

airborne and prohibit deployment before landing.

ACTION: This AD mandates revised limitations in the Westwind AFMs.

Each operator must incorporate Rev. TR#8 for 1124 models & TR#9 for 1124A models to the Westwind aircrafts AFMs.

COMPLIANCE: Unless already accomplished, comply with this AD before next

flight.
