SUBJECT:

Fire Protection - Extinguishing - Inspection and Modification of Wiring to the

Nacelle Fire Extinguisher.

BACKGROUND:

Due to a concern for improperly routed control wiring and a too long wire

harness which could result in wrong connection to the nacelle fire

extinguishers, the SAD No 1-59 was issued. If, however, the clamp reducing the free harness length for some reason will be removed there is still a risk

for incorrectly connected wire harness.

An incorrectly connected wire harness will cause the fire extinguishant to transfer to the opposite nacelle fire zone when discharging the extinguisher and then only one extinguisher, rather than two as under normal conditions,

will be available to extinguish a fire in the nacelle fire zone.
