

Stabilizers - Rudder - Inspection of Rudder Lower Rib

BACKGROUND:

Fatigue damages has been found in the bottom rib of the rudder. On one aircraft loose pieces of the web have been found inside the

rudder.

Extensive damages to the bottom rib may lead to damage of

primary structure in the rudder.

ACTIONS:

Perform actions described in Saab Aircraft AB Service Bulletin SAAB 2000-55-005 dated 2 February, 1996, or later revision.

COMPLIANCE

TIME:

- 1) To be performed within 20 calendar days from the effective date of this SAD.
- 2) Thereafter perform inspection weekly or at 400 flight hours interval, depending on result of the inspection.

remove the periodical inspection requirement.
