Description:	Hartzell has published the referenced service a plication to inform owners and operators of aircrait will pertain Harzell propellers installed that instances of bolt failure brown pen reported on certain B-3386-14H counterweight and attachment bolts, causing the counterweight sluctors a parate from the propeller. Bolt failure may lead to counterweight and separation from the propeller, possibly resulting in tampe, visco and reduced control of the aircraft.
