Subject: EUROCOPTER helicopters - Main Gear Box - Notification of

Unapproved Parts due to Theft

Ref. Publication: Safety Information Notice N°2168-S-63, revision 0 dated

10 March 2010.

Applicability: EUROCOPTER AS 332 all models, EC 225 LP, AS 350 all

models, EC 130 B4, AS 355 all models.

Description: EASA has been informed by EUROCOPTER that a number of

parts for Main Gear Box (MGB) intended for use on EUROCOPTER helicopters have been stolen from a facility of

one of its subcontractors in Marseille (France).

The affected MGB parts are the following:

The manufacturing process of these MGB parts is finished (part and serial numbers are marked) however their final compliance and quality control has not been performed by EUROCOPTER (no conformity marking), and no EASA Form One has been issued by EUROCOPTER.

These parts are considered as not approved and should not be installed on helicopters referred in the "Applicability" paragraph of this Service Information Bulletin.

Owners, operators and maintenance organizations, are encouraged to inspect their helicopter and/or helicopter parts inventory for the referenced part numbers. If these MGB parts are found in existing inventory, it is recommended that they be quarantined to prevent installation. Then, it is recommended to inform EUROCOPTER immediately.
