



## EASA Safety Information Bulletin

**Issued:** 28 July 2015

**Subject:** Suspected Unapproved Parts Notification

**Applicability:** Aircraft components

**Description:** The Belgian Civil Aviation Authority informed EASA that the following company, buying and selling aircraft components, is subject to a judicial investigation in Belgium:

Name: Aviation Support Europe  
Address: Nijverheidslaan 21F, 3200 Aarschot, Belgium

**Recommendation(s):** Owners, operators, maintenance organisations and distributors having already bought any aircraft component from Aviation Support Europe, are encouraged to quarantine it, to prevent its installation on any aircraft.

It is also recommended to inform accordingly the competent authority and the Belgian Civil Aviation Authority – Aviation Safety Inspectorate.
