#### 2. REASONS:

This Ale issued do to the following situation:

COPICE AS 350 Service Bulletin (SB) No. 01.00.35 enables the conversion of an AS 350 version B nelicopter to an AS 350 version BA helicopter, and changes the all-up weight of the helicopter from 1.05 kg to 2,100 kg.

However 3B No. 01.00.35 does not prohibit the use of the emergency flotation gear, which is still limited to an all-up weight of 1,950 kg.

Consequently, the all-up operating weight of helicopters, equipped with emergency flotation gear specified in § 1, is limited to 1,950 kg for all flights over water.

## 3. MANDATORY ACTION AND COMPLIANCE TIME:

The following measure is rendered mandatory from the effective date of this AD:

The all-up operating weight of helicopters equipped with emergency flotation gear specified in § 1 above, is limited to 1,950 kg for all flights over water.
