1. EFFECTIVITY:

EC 155 B and B1, AS 365 N3 and 366 G1 helpopters, equipped with a main gearbox (MGB) PN: 365A32-6002-XX or PN: 365A32-6001-XX PI. 365A32-9001-XX, fitted with a dual pump MGB lubrication system.

Note: This Airworthiness Directive (As is intended for maintenance personnel and crews.

2. REASON:

This AD is issued following a resort of crossed connection of the low-pressure switch of the MGB main lubrication system with the low-pressure switch of the MGB auxiliary lubrication system.

In the event of a fair e of the main system, crossed connection will lead to illumination of the failure warning light that prresponds to the auxiliary system and, in this case, the pilot would not take the actions instruct to by the Fight Manual in the event of a failure of the main system.

MACORY ACTIONS AND COMPLIANCE TIMES:

The following measures are rendered mandatory as from the effective date of this AD:

3.1 No later than during the next 110 flying hours or three months (whichever occurs first), check the connection of the MGB oil pressure switches in compliance with the instructions specified in § 2.B. of the EUROCOPTER Alert Telexes (AT) referenced below.

3.2 Particular attention:

Pending completion of the check of the connections, pilots must pay particular attention in the event of illumination of the auxiliary lubrication system failure warning light.

In this case, apply the procedure stipulated in Flight Manual section 3.2, which covers the case of main lubrication system failure.
