1. EFFECTIVITY:

This Airworthiness Directive (AD) is applicable to APM 20 LIONCEAU SN 7, 10, 11 and 12.

2. <u>REASONS</u>:

During scheduled maintenance operations, cracks on the engine mount have been discovered on several aircraft. Expertises proved that these cracks appear due to vibrations from the oil tank attachment.

This AD requires attaching the oil tank directly on the firewall in accordance with the manufacturer's approved design.

3. MANDATORY ACTIONS AND COMPLIANCE TIMES:

The following measures are rendered mandatory from the effective date of this AD, unless previously accomplished:

- At the latest, within the next 110 flight hours, perform the ISSOIRE AVIATION Service Bulletin No 46.

These actions must be done in accordance with the manufacturer's technical Publications.
