Applicability:	RB211 Trent 895-17, 892-17, 892B-17, 884-17, 884B-17, 877-17 and 875-17, known to be installed on Boeing 777 series aeroplanes.	
Reason:	Following a request from Rolls-Royce plc, EASA agreed to delay the implementation of AD 2006-0238 following the identification of problems with the associated Service Bulletin (RB211-72-AE935, as referenced by the AD). As the Effective Date of the AD (16 October 2006) had not been reached it was decided that the AD be withdrawn and subsequently be replaced by a new AD when the Service Bulletin is revised. Rolls-Royce has carried out a survey to confirm to the satisfaction of the Agency that the anticipated delays in the introduction of this action will not impact Airworthiness. It is anticipated the new AD will be issued in December 2006 with an Effective date of 31 January.
