<p>Reason:</p>	<p>The BAE Systems BAe 146/AVRO 146-RJ Aircraft Maintenance Manual (AMM) includes Chapter 05-10 "Time Limits" and Chapter 05-20 "Scheduled Maintenance Tasks", which have been identified as mandatory actions for continued airworthiness. Revision 90 of the AMM includes revisions to Chapters 05-10-15 and 05-20-00.</p> <p>To ensure that the affected aircraft comply with the mandatory actions for continued airworthiness, CAA United Kingdom issued Airworthiness Directive (AD) G-2005-0015 (EASA approval number 2005-5986) to require the implementation of the tasks and limitations specified in Chapters 05-10 and 05-20 at Revision 82 of the AMM.</p> <p>This new AD retains the requirements of that AD, which is superseded, and adds the changes made to the affected Chapters since that AD was issued.</p>

Compliance:	From the effective date of this directive, comply with the requirements of BAe 146/AVRO 146-RJ Aircraft Maintenance Manual (AMM) Chapters 05-10 "Time Limits" and 05-20 "Scheduled Maintenance Tasks" at AMM Revision 90 or later approved revisions.
